Stroke—Act FAST

A stroke is a “brain attack” caused by a disturbance in the blood supply to the brain. It is a medical emergency and requires immediate medical attention. Recognising the signs of stroke and calling 999 for an ambulance is crucial.

When stroke strikes, act **FAST**.

Face—has their face fallen on one side? Can they smile?

Arms—can they raise both arms and keep them there?

Speech—is their speech slurred?

Time to call 999—if you see any single one of these signs.

The sooner somebody who is having a stroke gets urgent medical attention, the better their chances of a good recovery
